Duties and Responsibilities:

Plan and provide intensive care monitoring and advance emergency care support to ill and injured patients during air medical evacuations primarily by helicopter and fixed wing platforms.

Provides medical services at the scope and level of a Respiratory Therapists to preserve the health of employees and client personnel.

Systematically assesses the urgent or emergent health needs of patients, analyzes data, and formulates a plan of care, with other members of the medical team, which is realistic in relation to the employee's capabilities and job requirements.
